With the approval of the Mover and Seconder, the following condition was added:

i. That a new condition no. 5 be added to read as follows:

Prior to any work commencing on-site, a Works Management Plan (WMP) shall be prepared and submitted to the specification of the City of Cockburn and to the satisfaction of the Western Australian Planning Commission. The approved Works Management Plan shall be implemented thereafter.

That the Metro Outer Joint Development Assessment Panel resolves to:

1. **Approve** DAP Application reference DAP/20/01838 and accompanying modified plan dated 15 January 2021; pursuant to Clause 30 of the Metropolitan Region Scheme, subject to the following conditions:

Conditions

- This decision constitutes planning approval only and is valid for a period of two years from the date of approval. If the subject development is not substantially commenced within the specified period, the approval shall lapse and be of no further effect.
- 2. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the terms of the application as approved herein and any approved plans.
- 3. Prior to any work commencing on-site, a Noise and Vibration Management Plan shall be prepared and submitted to the specification of the City of Cockburn and to the satisfaction of the Western Australian Planning Commission. The approved Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan is to be implemented thereafter.
- 4. Prior to any work commencing on-site, a Dust Management Plan shall be prepared and submitted to the specification of the City of Cockburn and to the satisfaction of the Western Australian Planning Commission. The approved Dust Management Plan shall be implemented thereafter.

Prior to any work commencing on-site, a Works Management Plan (WMP) shall be prepared and submitted to the specification of the City of Cockburn and to the satisfaction of the Western Australian Planning Commission. The approved Works Management Plan shall be implemented thereafter.

Advice Notes

- This decision constitutes planning approval under the Metropolitan Region Scheme only. It is the proponent's responsibility to comply with all other applicable legislation and obtain all required approvals, licences and permits prior to commencement of this development.
- 2. With regard to dust, an Application for Approval of a Dust Management Plan form may be obtained from www.cockburn.wa.gov.au, and shall identify the mitigation and contingency measures proposed by the developer. Appropriate mitigation and contingency measures are outlined in the *Department Water and Environment Regulation* publication "Land development sites and impacts on air quality" (November 1996). The developer is further advised that Council approval may be required for bulk earthworks on Class 3 and 4 development sites between 1 October and 31 March the following year.
- 3. The Works Management Plan (WMP) shall address the following items:
 - Access to and from the site and internal vehicle movements;
 - Delivery of materials and equipment to the site;
 - Storage of materials and equipment on the site;
 - Parking arrangements for contractors and subcontractors;
 - Management of construction waste;
 - Management of light spill; and
 Other matters likely to impact on the surrounding properties

The Report Recommendation was put and CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

REASON: The application is assessed as being compatible with the zonings for the site and subject to satisfying the approval conditions, will not cause any adverse impact on surrounding land uses.

The proposed works relate to nearby major public infrastructure (waste water treatment plant); panel members noting the sustainability significance of this exploratory work towards restoring our underground water resources.
