Work has started on Visko Park bowling and recreation facility

Work to construct the new Cockburn Bowling and Recreation Facility at Visko Park in Yangebup has begun.

Once complete in July 2018, it will replace the 50-year-old Cockburn Bowling Club in Spearwood.

More than \$4.55M of funding for the \$9.5M project was contributed via a National Stronger Regions Fund grant from the Commonwealth Government.

The facility will be built by Crothers Construction and will include:

- A large multi-purpose activity and function room (available for community hire)
- A new bowling club members' area with a bar, darts area, TAB and two new bowling greens
- A commercial kitchen to cater for functions and other meals
- Meeting and office facilities
- Beach volleyball courts (community hire and membership)
- Futsal courts (membership model)
- 150 car bays including accessible car bays
- Vehicle access from Birchley Road
