## The Ceiling Hoist - what to do and how it works




 Hold and use the spreader bar to pull the hoist into a clear area for safe use. Make sure there are no obstructions around you


 Take care to familiarise yourself with the features of this hoist

**Emergency Stop** 


Lifting Strap Spreader bar



The hand control, spreader bar and your sling




- The hoist has 2 buttons up and down
- Do not pull hard on the hand control cord
- When the hand control is not in use clip the hand control over the spreader bar (left) to keep it safely out of the way
- Keep all obstructions clear when lifting



## If the hoist doesn't work

#### When you are finished...



- If the hoist is not working, check to see if the red Emergency Stop cord has been pulled into the down position, disabling the hoist.
- PULL AND HOLD EMERGENCY CORD TO LOWER HOIST IF REQUIRED
- To re-enable hoist, push white clip attached to the top of the red Emergency Stop cord with your finger or use the end of the spreader bar to reach.
